SUMMARY:

- The avionics maintenance technician reports to the director of maintenance part 145. The technician carries out directives concerning scheduled and unscheduled inspections/repairs and other related functions performed by the repair station and as outlined in the quality control manual. Performs maintenance on aircraft avionics components and electrical systems components e.g., airborne navigation/communication systems, weather radar, autopilot, compass systems and accessories in accordance with MFG specifications and FAA guidelines

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Ensures avionics systems of aircraft are performing according to quality control manual
- Troubleshoots to determine malfunctions on aircraft avionics components and electrical systems components, such as airborne navigation/communications systems/ weather radar, autopilot, compass systems and accessories component level
- Test and inspects aircraft communication components, navigations components, weather radar, autopilot, compass systems and accessories to MFG specifications
- Repair aircraft communication systems/wiring, navigation system/wiring, autopilot and other electrical systems/wiring.
- Uses all mandated safety equipment and complies with all safety requirements in accordance with company and government regulations and guidelines
- Completes all checklist, form and reports as required in accordance with the company, government and FAA regulations guidelines
- Responsible for the quality and quantity of work being performed. Man-hours expended, interpretation of written and verbal instructions as well as job assignments and job priorities as dictated by the department supervisor. Meets or exceed responsibilities and duties outlined in the quality control manual
- Reports production delays, cost changes or other problems to the department supervisor
- Responsible for the cleanliness of the maintenance work area, paying particular attention to the protection of aircraft interiors and components removed from the aircraft
- Oversees the proper and accurate tagging and identification of all parts and components removed
- Ensures that rejected and unserviceable parts are handled in such a way as to prevent their reuse as serviceable parts
- Exhibits positive, courteous behavior with customers, businesses and co-workers
