JOB SUMMARY

The Aircraft Maintenance Technician reports to the Aircraft Crew Chief for assignment of work scope tasks and is responsible for the efficient execution of the work scope tasks assigned. The AMT performs tasks as required by the work scope with efficiency and to quality standards and utilizes the applicable technical data relative to work performed including but not limited to maintenance and inspection, servicing and lubrication, troubleshooting, repair and modifications and fueling and de-fueling.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform tasks as required by the work scope with efficiency and to quality standards and utilize the applicable technical data relative to work performed including but not limited to: maintenance and inspection, servicing and lubrication, troubleshooting, repair and modifications, fueling and de-fueling.

The Aircraft Crew Chief reports to the Operations Manager and is responsible for the efficient execution of the work scope and for the maintenance, preventive maintenance and alterations performed under the authority of the FAA Certificated Repair Station. The Aircraft Crew Chief performs tasks and ensures tasks, within the scope of their normally assigned duties, are performed using established standards of quality and airworthiness.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Monitors all work performed by the crew to ensure that all work accomplished meets quality standards and is airworthy
- Ensures that aircraft maintenance paperwork and forms are completed in accordance with methods of execution outlined in the RSM/QCM
- Collaborates and cooperates with the assigned QA Inspector to achieve aircraft approval for return to service

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provides physical response, assessments, and coordinates spill or release follow-up in accordance with applicable regulations.
- Administrator for administration of Environmental data bases for regulated materials and reports generation. Includes SDS and electronic library of materials subject to environmental regulation, plus obsolescence files as required to address environmental regulatory requirements.
- Responsible for administration and data entry for regulatory reporting data base and ACCESS conversions.
- Responsible for assuring calculation of regulatory tech data for data entry.
- Maintains company training records.
- Manage or conducts indoctrination training for all new employees.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Associate degree in environmental science, engineering, technology, or related. May substitute directly related experience for education.

- Must have current Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), DOT Hazardous Materials (HM), and OSHA Hazardous Waste Operations (HAZWOP) training and certifications or ability to obtain within (3) months.

JOB SUMMARY

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Identifies, verifies, counts and processes all incoming and outgoing materials and documentation utilizing a data processing system and in accordance with company policies and procedures.
- Responds to after-hours support requests, as assigned, preparing documentation and completing data processing transactions as described by company policies and procedures.
- Performs general tasks, as required, which includes, but not limited to unloading trucks, operating forklifts, placing and storing parts, unpacking and packing parts, general housekeeping, operating various equipment such as scales, etc.
- Ensure all new company tools are properly received, marked and stored. Track tools throughout their life use to include disposal. Responsible for monitoring, maintenance of and reporting lost/broken tools for repair/replacement.

JOB SUMMARY

Sanding and preparing surfaces for paint, mixing paint products, applying paint products, wet sanding paint finishes after painting and buffing color sanded paint area to final finish. Individually and cooperatively apply aircraft top coat paint applications. Identifying proper paint products for particular aircraft, research paint codes for specific projects, contact paint suppliers when needed and work with buyer to obtain required paint. Maintain inventory of painting consumables work with buyer for replenishment as required.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Works from drawings, sketches, pictures or verbal specifications to layout design for painting aircraft, aircraft parts and sub-assemblies, including "N" numbers, stripes, patterns, designs as required.
- Prepares surfaces to be painted by sanding, cleaning and conversion coating.
- Strips paint from aircraft, aircraft parts or sub-assemblies.
- Selects and mixes proper paint to the Manufacturer's specifications to meet job requirements— May be required to experiment with special paints and related products.
- Sets up and uses spray gun for proper application of urethane and epoxy paints.
- Touches up aircraft with brush and/or spray gun blend-in techniques.
- Assists /trains others in the performance of their job assignments.
- Works in a safe manner in accordance with OSHA and Company safety procedures.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- High School diploma or GED
- Minimum 3 years painting experience with applying a high quality topcoat to specific aircraft specs
- Must be able to work from designs or verbal instructions to perform layout design
- Must be familiar with applicable manufacturer standards and Company procedure governing the care and treatment of aluminum
- Must be able to operate standard spray paint equipment: buffers, paint guns, sanding equipment, dual action orbital sander and common hand tools
- Able to walk, climb, and stand for extended periods of time
- Must have the physical and muscular dexterity to stand or kneel for extended periods of time during painting, sanding or while working on aircraft
- Must be able to lift and carry 50 pounds with or without reasonable accommodation
- Must not be abnormally allergic while applying paint, paint stripper, solvents, primers, or other related products that produce fumes or dust. Able to wear a respirator.

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
