The A&P maintenance technician reports to the director of maintenance part 145. The technician carries out directives concerning scheduled and unscheduled inspections/repairs and other related functions performed by the repair station and as outlined in the quality control manual. The main objective is to maintain aircraft in a safe condition to fly by servicing, repairing, and troubleshooting systems including airframes, engines, electrical and hydraulic systems, avionics equipment and aircraft instruments.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Ensures employees are conforming to company policies and procedures, such as OSHA standards and quality control manual
- Responsible for the quality and quantity of work being performed. Man-hours expended, interpretation of written and verbal instructions as well as job assignments and job priorities as dictated by supervisor
- Meets or exceed responsibilities and duties outlined in the quality control manual
- Reports production delays, cost changes or other problems to the department supervisor
- Responsible for the cleanliness of the maintenance work area, paying particular attention to the protection of aircraft interiors and components removed from the aircraft
- Oversees the proper and accurate tagging and identification of all parts and components removed
- Ensures that rejected and un-serviceable parts are handled in such a way as to prevent their reuse as serviceable parts
- Performs aircraft towing, fueling, performing aircraft NAV and fault downloads
- Researches and orders parts.
- Other duties may be required, as needed
